Sue Detweiler's experience in marriage, motherhood, and ministry exemplifies the life of a woman who has embraced her call and is fully alive to all that God has created her to be.

Sue is a gifted teacher, speaker, writer, and leader. As a faithful steward, Sue has developed her God-given talent to communicate and articulate profound truths in simple and relatable ways.

Trial by Fire:

As a young mom, Sue Detweiler nearly lost her 5 week old baby when she awoke to find her house on fire. By God's grace she and her baby were rescued, but afterwards she felt as if her whole life was "on fire" as she struggled to rebuild her house and home.

"A breakthrough in my life took place when I realized that I couldn't do anything apart from God. Staying connected to the life-giving strength of Jesus Christ is the only way I can parent my children and be an encouragement to other's. I was already an ordained minister pastoring a church with my husband, but being saved from the fire, gave me a heart to help save others going through 'fires' in their lives."

Approaching her 30th birthday in 1993, she felt led by God to launch a radio program to encourage other young mothers who shared her struggles. Feeling like she was not an expert at being a mom, she obeyed anyway and launched a syndicated radio feature called, "Harmony at Home."

Putting it all on the Altar, again and again:

As the ministry began to grow, she had an opportunity to expand her outreach to television. She had four children under seven and, after much prayer, felt God was calling her to put all of her energy into His #1 priority - her family. So, like Abraham, she put her media ministry on the altar, pouring her life into her husband, children, and local church. While homeschooling her young family, she became the Principal of New Song Christian Academy where her children were enrolled, oversaw LIFE School of Ministry an award-winning Bible Training Institute for pastors and leaders, taught Bible and Theology, and served as an Associate Pastor at New Song Christian Fellowship.

In 2007, just when it seemed like things were finally settling down with her "picture perfect" children moving into their older teenage years, God began to speak to Sue and Wayne about his desire to birth a "Spirit of Adoption" in North American Christians through them. She heard the Lord say "Well done, but I have more children for you."

Once again, they laid everything on the altar and adopted two young orphan boys from Brazil. Unaware of the emotional and learning challenges they would face, Sue and Wayne quickly became intimately aware of the day to day struggles of helping "orphans" become sons.

A deeper message, a broader ministry:

Called by God to bring healing and redemption, God is now calling Sue to take the depth of life experience He has given her as a result of her obedience and share it with everyone through radio, video, writing and speaking. Sue is an inspiration and a voice of stability offering men and women a Biblical perspective and practical help.
